

**External Release Notes – Insights for Fire Incidents v1.17.0 (12/13/23)**

The ESO Fire Incidents and Insights teams released 11 new columns to the “Fire Incidents” in Insights.

**Fire Incidents Data Model:**

All of these new columns combine (concatenate) existing columns into a single column to make this data more convenient and usable in Insights. The descriptions below will show a recurring pattern column1 + columns 2 = new column. The individual columns being combined originate from the same table as the new/combined column.
