

External Release Notes – ESO Insights (8/9/2023)

This week, the ESO Insights team is introducing several enhancements to the Insights application, as well as a UI bugfix for the Data Dictionary inside of Insights. The details are outlined below.

1. Insights Designers have a completely new feature of Insights available called “Personal Folders”. This can be used for organizing Dashboards that you have created. There is a separate PDF available in the Release Notes section of the ESO Suite Dashboard which contains a more detailed “how to” to help you explore this feature in greater depth.
2. The Data Exporter is now configured to execute all queued exports at the top of every hour (i.e., at 12:00, 13:00, 14:00, and so on). Previously, although exports would execute within 60 minutes of being submitted, the execution was not associated with specific times of the day. This enhancement will make the timing of your exports more predictable.
3. For NEMSIS v3.5.0 customers of Insights StateRepo, the Data Exporter now includes a NEMSIS_3_5 data model when creating new exports. This is in addition to the NEMSIS_3_4 data model that has been available since the launch of the Data Exporter.
4. We have fixed a navigational bug in the Insights Data Dictionary. Previously, if you have selected a submenu item on the left-hand menu of the Dictionary (for example: “Times” under “Incident”), then you navigate directly to another top tab in the Dictionary (for example, clicking “Flowchart”), you would be placed into a submenu item that is not the top of the list for that top tab. Now, when navigating between top tabs, you will be placed at the top of the submenu items.
