

## **Insights App 1.14.2 Release Notes**

On 1/4/23, ESO released an update to the Insights EMS data source which has the potential to cause errors in customer Insights Dashboards that use this data source.

### **What Has Changed and Why?**

There are two fields related to ROSC that were changed from an integer data type to a Boolean data type. This change was made so that the values for these fields were more human-friendly and make more sense in the context of Dashboards.

### **How Do I Resolve This Issue?**

If you use either of these fields in a Dashboard that you created before 1/4/23, then you are likely to see an error graphic like this:



These fields could have been used as a data element in a Widget, Widget filter, or Dashboard filter.

To fix the problem, you simply need to remove then re-add the field in whatever location it is being used. If you were using this element in a filter, be sure to re-add the desired filter criteria (i.e., to include or exclude certain records by using this element).
