

Insights EMS Data Model Schema 1.8.7 Release Notes

On 2/1/23, ESO released an update to the Insights EMS data source which has the potential to cause errors in customer Insights Dashboards that use this data source.

What Has Changed and Why?

The ESO EHR and Insights teams have updated a single table name, and have added five new tables, all of which are related to specialty forms for strokes.

How Do I Resolve Any Issues?

If you use any of the fields in the *Updated Table* section in a Dashboard that you created before 2/1/23, then you are likely to see an error graphic like this:



These fields could have been used as a data element in a Widget, Widget filter, or Dashboard filter.

To fix the problem, you simply need to remove then re-add the field in whatever location it is being used. If you were using this element in a filter, be sure to re-add the desired filter criteria (i.e., to include or exclude certain records by using this element).
