ESO now enables you to measure performance against the new EMS Compass performance standards. More Compass reports will be coming as the standards are approved.

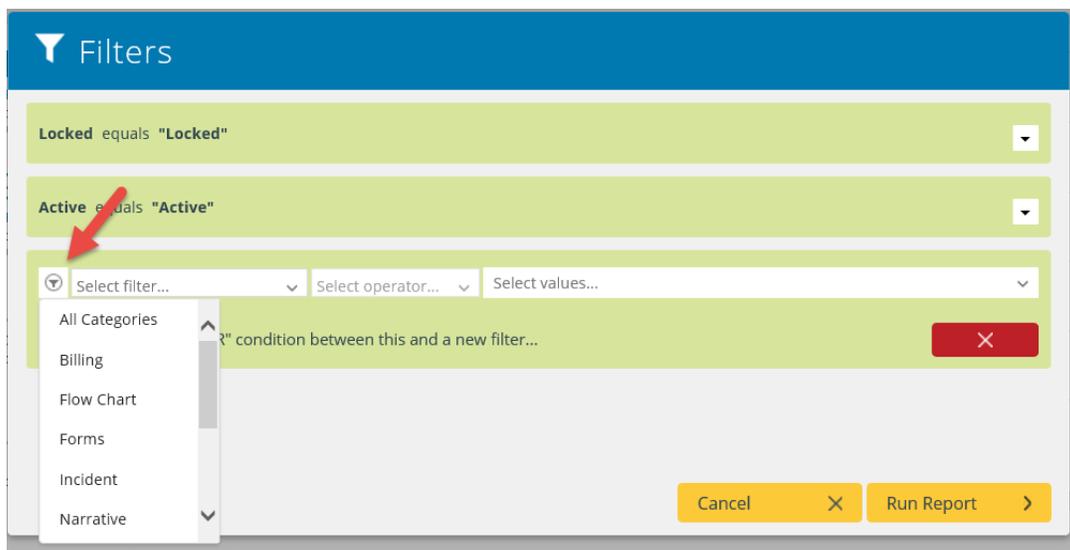

New Filter Grouping

Don't know the name of a filter? ESO helps by grouping filters by tab and topic. Click on the downward arrow on the left side of the filter selection row to pull up a list of filter groups. The filter list will be narrowed to only those that apply to that category.



NEMSIS 3 Values Available

ESO Analytics has been updated to accommodate NEMSIS 3 values. Once you have moved to EHR and converted to NEMSIS 3, you will see your data presented using the NEMSIS 3 values. We have carried over the NEMSIS 2 to NEMSIS 3 mapping from EHR to Analytics. The following fields have been updated to include new NEMSIS 3 values.

- Primary Impression
- Secondary Impression
- Support Primary Sign Symptom
- EMD Complaint
- Priority
- Run Type
- Disposition
- Vehicle Type
- Location Type

The drill-through will display the most applicable context regardless as to what version the record was recorded. As an example, in the Total Record Volume by Disposition report, a NEMSIS 3 users will see the NEMSIS 3 Disposition values listed in the main table. In the drill-through, NEMSIS 3 call records for "Cancelled (No Patient Contact)" will show that NEMSIS 3 value and the NEMSIS 2 calls will show "Call Cancelled".

For fields with no changes or a 1:1 mapping between NEMSIS 2 and NEMSIS 3, there are no changes to the report display.

User Interface Change

We have hidden Trend Line Legend so that it does not cover up important data. To see the legend, click on Trend Lines on the menu bar.
